How to read the table:

- 1) The column "Total Cap.Changes" gives the total change in paper production.
- 2) The column "Capacity changes" gives the total change in paper production in the cases where recovered paper forms a part of the raw material furnish (totally or partly).
- 3) The column "RP Total" gives an estimation on the total change in the recovered paper utilisation.
- 4) The changes are then divided between the types of recovered paper.
- 5) A project is considered as 'decided' when the construction has started or machine ordered.
Otherwise, a project is classified as 'planned'. The table sums up 'decided' and 'planned' projects.
- 6) Groups of recovered paper grades (according to the EN643 European List of Standard Grades of Recovered Paper and Board):
 - Mixed Grades: 1.01, 1.02, 1.03, 5.01, 5.02, 5.03, 5.05
 - Corrugated and Kraft: 1.04, 1.05, 4.01, 4.02, 4.03, 4.04, 4.05, 4.06, 4.07, 4.08, 5.04
 - Newspapers and Magazines: 1.06, 1.07, 1.08, 1.09, 1.10, 1.11, 2.01, 2.02
 - High Grades: 2.03, 2.04, 2.05, 2.06, 2.07, 2.08, 2.09, 2.10, 2.11, 2.12, 3.01, 3.02, 3.03, 3.04, 3.05, 3.06, 3.07, 3.08, 3.09, 3.10, 3.11, 3.12, 3.13, 3.14, 3.15, 3.16, 3.17, 3.18, 3.19, 5.06, 5.07
